

How to prepare for your SJCCA Audition

Dance

- Beginner dancers (less than 2 years of experience) – Please wear dance or athletic clothing that you can easily move and stretch in. The audition will consist of a warm up, across the floor exercises and a short dance combination.
- Intermediate and Advanced dancers (more than 2 years of experience) – Female dancers- Please wear a black leotard, pink tights and bring both ballet and jazz shoes. Male dancers- Please wear black shorts or pants and a white t-shirt and bring both ballet and jazz shoes. The audition will consist of a ballet warm up, across the floor technique and a short jazz combination.

Drama

- Students with no experience who would like to explore the Dramatic Arts in a non-performance Introductory class should attend the Theatre Workshops the morning of the 15th.
- Students wishing to audition for placement in a higher level Performance Class are asked to prepare a 1 - 2 minute, age appropriate monologue (fully memorized, showing creative character development, movement and stage presence). Please bring a head shot and resume (optional).

Visual Art

- Visual art auditions include a still life drawing that is completed during the audition (all materials provided)
- It is highly recommended that you bring a portfolio of your artwork to the audition

Chorus

- Students may prepare a short song to perform, but it is not required.
- Students will also be vocalized to help determine pitch accuracy and range.

Band

- Prospective students will have the opportunity to try out a variety of woodwind, brass, and percussion instruments. The "Instrument zoo" is for students with no instrumental experience who are interested in taking beginning band for the 2019-2020 school year.
