This will take you to a link on the Murray Media Center's webpage that contains a huge assortment of books that are organized by genre. Select and read a book (or books) that you would enjoy. Keep track of what you read on the Reading Log that is provided by writing a short summary or reflection every 25 pages. Your final entry should include a rating of the book on a 1-10 scale and one or two sentences explaining the rating. **You should fill out one log for each book you read.** Finally, bring the completed log(s) in to your Language Arts teacher during the first week of school, and you will receive Live School points! Your teacher will award you five points for each book you read and log. You can read **up to** six books for a total of 30 Live School points! Remember, you can turn in these points for a variety of rewards and activities.

So, make reading a part of a fun and restful summer, and start the new school year with points in your account. I look forward to seeing everyone in the fall!
